

COVID POLICY AND MITIGATION STRATEGY

BY REGISTERING FOR THE NATIONAL POLE VAULT SUMMIT YOU HAVE AGREED TO FOLLOW THE BELOW COVID POLICY AND MITIGATION STRATEGY.

The National Pole Vault Summit will adhere to, comply with, and enforce the most current State and Local guidelines - subject to change to reflect the most current State and local guidelines.

1. DAILY SCREENING:

Conduct daily home screenings for symptoms. [NV Health Response COVID Screening checklist for Sports.](#)

- a. If you are symptomatic or have been symptomatic within 10 days of the event, please stay home and submit a [COVID Refund Exemption. Request Exemption here.](#)
- b. If you have had close contact with a confirmed COVID case, please be prepared to show negative COVID test.

2. FACE COVERING INDOORS:

Nevada mandates **face coverings INDOORS** whether vaccinated or not.

- a. This is an indoor event and face coverings will be required for all attendees unless actively engaging in learn by doing activities, warming up for competition or actively competing. For more information about [Nevada face covering mandate.](#)

3. PHYSICAL DISTANCING:

Maintain physical distance of 6' or more whenever possible.

- a. New Credential pick up location and staggered times may be implemented to reduce overcrowding.
- b. The number of participants and competitors per area may be limited or reduced to help alleviate large numbers from congregating.

4. WASH AND DISINFECT:

Practice clean hygiene, hand washing and disinfecting often.

- a. The Pole Vault Summit will make some hand sanitizer and spray disinfectants available but it is recommended to bring your own.
- b. When possible, the National Pole Vault Summit and venues will clean and sanitize common areas. Poles rented by the Pole Vault Summit will be sanitized after each use.
